



AATF Peptide

LOCATION: 12 amino acids near the carboxy terminus of human AATF (1).

APPLICATION:

The peptide is used for blocking the activity of AATF antibody (catalog number 3039). It usually blocks the antibody activity completely in Western blot by incubating the peptide with equal volume of antibody for 30 min at 37°C.

For research use only.

STORAGE:

It is supplied as 50 µg at 200 µg/ml in PBS pH7.2 (10 mM NaH₂PO₄, 10 mM Na₂HPO₄, 130 mM NaCl) containing 0.1% bovine serum albumin and 0.02% sodium azide. Store at -20°C, stable for one year.
