## Bax (NT) Peptide

**CATALOG NO.:** 3351P

**LOCATION:** 16 amino acids near the amino-terminus of human Bax (1).

**APPLICATION:**

The peptide is used for blocking the activity of anti-Bax antibody (catalog number 3351). It usually blocks the antibody activity completely in Western blot by incubating the peptide with equal volume of antibody for 30 min at 37°C.

**For research use only.**

**STORAGE:**

It is supplied as 50 µg at 200 µg/ml in PBS pH7.2 (10 mM NaH<sub>2</sub>PO<sub>4</sub>, 10 mM Na<sub>2</sub>HPO<sub>4</sub>, 130 mM NaCl) containing 0.1% bovine serum albumin and 0.02% sodium azide. Store at -20°C, stable for one year.
